
Q2 How long have you been employed at SRJC?







Q5 Do you have a disability?





Q6 What type of disability do you have? Check all that apply.





Q7 Are you aware of the District's reasonable accommodation policy?







Q12 Do you identify as LGBTQIA+?





Q21 How would you categorize the level of interactions among racial/ethnic groups on our campus?










Q26 Did you report the incident?





Q37 What is your gender?









Q40 What is your marital status?








