



**DIRECTIONS TO SRJC HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT**  
*(Located in the Bussman Hall Annex Building at the Santa Rosa Campus)*

From south of campus:

- Take Hwy 101 north to Santa Rosa
- Take the College Avenue exit (sixth exit in Santa Rosa)
- Turn right onto College Avenue off of the off-ramp
- Make an immediate left onto Morgan Street at the first light
- Turn left at Carillo Street (first stop sign)
- Carillo winds around to the right and becomes Armory Drive at the turn
- Drive north on Armory for about one mile
- Turn right onto Scholars Drive
- Visitor parking spaces are available in the parking lot between Baker Hall and Bailey Hall
- Enter the SRJC Human Resources Department reception area on the East side of the Building

From north of campus:

- Take Hwy 101 south to Santa Rosa
- Take the Steele Lane exit (fifth exit in Santa Rosa)
- Turn left onto Steele Lane off of the off-ramp
- Drive under the freeway overpass and turn right at Illinois Avenue (first light)
- Illinois winds around to the right and becomes Armory Drive at the turn
- Drive south on Armory for about 1/2 mile
- Turn left onto Scholars Drive
- Visitor parking spaces are available in the parking lot between Baker Hall and Bailey Hall
- Enter the SRJC Human Resources Department reception area on the East side of the Building
